

118.) Du kannst nicht zwei Herren dienen / Don't serve two Masters - Parminder Biant 07.05.2020

Wrong form of worship:

Mat 6,24

No man can serve two masters: for either he will hate the one, and love the other; or else he will hold to the one, and despise the other. Ye cannot serve God and mammon.

Mammon = riches, personification of wealth

Serving = worship

They have turned riches or treasures into a person, the personification of something.

This is idolatry: taking a stone, personify it and treat it like a God.

AA 73,4

The church would have been in danger if all these people that would joining the church as it began to increase rapidly in number, if they profess to serve God, the actually served the mammon.

AA 137.3

Cornelius

Peter enters into Cornelius' home and he treats Peter like someone who is honored from heaven.

It's custom to bow before a prince or a king, like children did with their parents.

But it was different with Cornelius, he brought reverence to Peter, he thought that he was basically a God and Peter was going to resist that.

AA 149.1

Herod goes to Cesarea

They declared the people that when they have ever respected Herod as a ruler, now they will worship him as a God.

It is crucial to understand parables:

We think that we worship God, but at the same time we ignore what is visibly around us. This is the problem of our movement and of all humanity.

SDA's understanding is that a Sunday law will come and they will be persecuted for keeping the Sabbath. They are claiming the right for each person to worship God on the right day after their conscience. They claim that it's their human right which no one can take from them – that is correct.

But at the same time some SDA believers take the right of their children when they punish them with no food or isolation and they do it in the name of God. Mistreating children in the name of God is wrong. Why? Because a human has the right for food and a loving relationship from birth. It is not a favor that the parents give him or take from him, but it is his natural, inviolable right.

This is what 1 John 4,20 means with loving God is a lie when you mistreat others.

The most important thing is love. It was not good that Adam was alone, so he received companionship. It was his right, his essential requirement.

God created humans because it is HIS right as well. He cannot survive by himself. God has to have a counterpart.

When Christian parents isolate their children, they take away their right, because God says it's not good to be alone.

It's your right to have food because it produces life and happiness.

For a parent to take that away from his child is mistreatment, slavery and abuse.

It is evil and sin to isolate your children and prevent them from eating.

We see here the concept, how it's a lie to worship God: Claim for themselves the right of the Sabbath for worship and at the same time take the natural rights from other humans.

This is the end time scenario and it is a prophetic subject. We are so focused on Sabbath/Sunday that we are missing the fulfillment of this issue as it is happening today.

It's so advanced that a regular SDA doesn't see it. We don't see the seriousness of what is going on.

What is happening in the USA right now?

Christians have promoted a person to do their will: Trump. He does what the people want. He is after their heart – like Saul, the first King, was a man after their heart.

The people want a Christian nation, they want to serve God and honor him: "In God we trust."

But exactly that is their evil. When they love God, they hate their neighbor.

With Trump they have now their man who is promoting exactly this: Love God above your neighbor.

But to love God above the neighbor is to hate God!

The Sabbath/Sunday controversy is nothing more than loving God above other humans.

Mat 6,24: You can't serve 2 masters.

Who are the 2 masters in our story here? God and who?

The mammon is not Satan. It's about money but your choice would not be your money, but the neighbor.

You have 2 choices: either worship God or worship your neighbor.

If you say you love God, you cannot love your neighbor.

Mat 6,24 says: You can't love 2 things!

God OR human, that's the choice from 1 John 4,20

If you choose to love God, you hate the human!

This issue is happening today. People have promoted God and say you must obey him. But when you do that, you will by definition hate your neighbor. That's what 1 John 4 says.

The SDA understanding is: Only by loving God you actually have the ability to love your neighbor!

This is so scarily wrong! It gets so far that we are prepared to lie, to give misinformation, to twist the story, to call people names, to humiliate people openly, swear and lie about them – and do this all because we love God so much.

The end justifies the means: When God is the end you can justify whatever you do to a human.

This is happening right now.

Trump's statement is: Make America great again. Why?

Dan 11,41: They want to make the USA the glorious land.

The underlying foreign policy agenda of the USA is to protect the glorious land (Israel).

They understand that there are two glorious lands. You can't protect Israel unless if you make America great again.

The USA must be a great Christian country. "In God we trust to protect Israel", because without Israel God will not return. That's the reason why the foreign US policy is so fixated about the middle East.

This doctrine is called Dispensationalism by two men: Darby and Scofield.

Trump is the figure head of these Christians, of Protestant America.

They want to put God before everything.

When you do that, besides being a liar, you end up hating your neighbor.

Where do we see that they hate their neighbor?

One issue is immigration and nationalism:

Trump was speaking about immigrants coming from central and southern America: "They are all murderers, rapists and gangsters." And right at the beginning he has enacted several immigration laws. He has to do that if he loves God.

The other issue is sexism:

Since decades there are two controversial issues in the USA regarding women's reproduction rights: Abortion and contraception.

It's all about the rights of women to control their own bodies.

We need to understand what the issues are: These people love God.

Why did God invent sex according to them? To make babies - like a factory.

Though shall not kill, means: no abortion.

But when you make these laws in the name of God, you end up hating human beings (women).

Most of these men are married and love their wives.

But the principle in relation to this issue is clear: You love God, you are forced to hate women.

The prophetic issue today is loving God and hating humans:

This is nationalism; that's why they are attacking immigrants and women's reproduction rights.

It's not that these men hate women in the way we might think. They say we love women, but the way they treat them is hatred.

John, the expert of love, doesn't say in soft words: "They don't treat women equally."

But instead he says: "They hate them."

The third issue is homophobia:

We still have to study out that subject and put it in the public domain.

We see the same principle here: "We love God" is the motivation for hating homosexual people.

Loving and obeying God means to have a problem with immigration, women's reproduction rights and rights for the LGBTQ community. Obeying God means taking from them their natural rights.

To receive medical care: Is it your right or is it a gift?

The body heals itself; it is built into your nature to automatically heal, so this issue should be obviously clear:

It's your right to receive medical care and be healed.

But Americans don't understand this principle. They treat it as a money making theme and it's all based upon their love of god rather than humans.

The American model is this:

You are a priest and you have to serve God rather than the man who is attacked by those robbers on the side of the road.

The Samaritan doesn't think that way. He doesn't even know God!

So their whole methodology is wrong.

It should amaze us that a nation that was supposed to be the glorious land, can get to a place where they think it's not your enviable right to receive medical care. They understand it as a gift that the state offers, but it is a natural right!

This is all based upon their perspective of God: If a man doesn't work, he should not receive medical care. They use this principle. God helps those who help themselves and they don't take care of the medical need of the most vulnerable people.

All these issues are based upon: Who do you worship? God or humans!?
