5. Colossians 1:27 - (10/01/19).

Col 1:26-27, *“Even the mystery which hath been hid from ages and from generations, but now is made manifest to his saints: To [by] whom God would make known what is the riches of the glory of this mystery among the Gentiles; which is Christ in you, the hope of glory:”*

- Mystery = Christ (not in you)
- Christ in you = the richness of the mystery
- 'manifest' : From G5318; to render apparent (literally or figuratively): -
- G5318 From G5316; shining, that is, apparent (literally or figuratively); neuter (as adverb) publicly, externally: -
- From ἐλπῶ elpō which is a primary word (to anticipate, usually with pleasure); expectation (abstract or concrete) or confidence: -

1 Cor 15:43

1Co 15:43, *“It is sown in dishonour; it is raised in glory: it is sown in weakness; it is raised in power:”*

- Seed = a corrupted person that it is sown (when it is buried) and it is raised in incorruption.
- This is a parable. Juxtaposition.

Co 15:44, *“It is sown a natural body; it is raised a spiritual body. [there's 1 body] [turning point] There is a natural body, and there is a spiritual body.” [there's 2 bodies]*

1Co 15:45, *“And so it is written [because there's 2 bodies it is written that:], The first man Adam was made a living soul; the last Adam was made a quickening spirit.”*

1Co 15:46, *“Howbeit that was not first which is spiritual, but that which is natural; and afterward that which is spiritual.”*
